

How do I report an occupational exposure to a bloodborne pathogen?

If you believe you have potentially been exposed to a bloodborne pathogen, you can report your exposure from myUK. Perform these steps to report your exposure.

1. Visit [myUK](#).
2. Click **Occupational Exposures**.



3. Click **Occupational Exposures**. The Occupational Exposures reporting page displays.



4. Read the page and click the link associated with your employment status at UK. You will be directed to a form where you can report your exposure or receive instructions to report an exposure.
